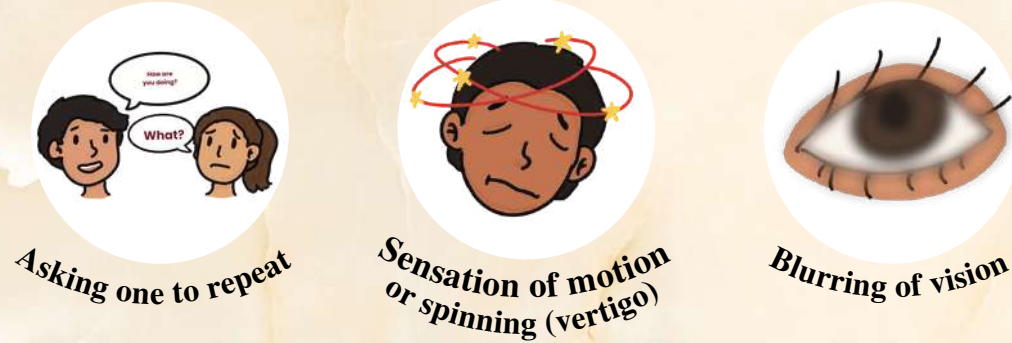
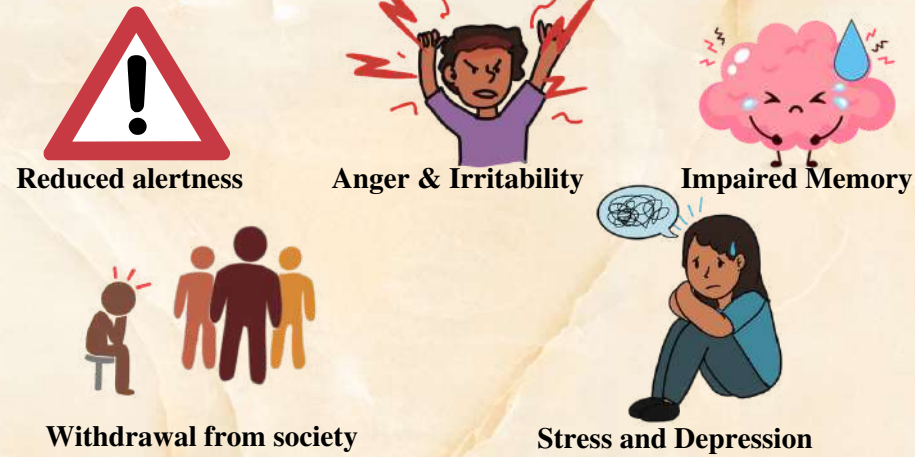


Department of Hearing Sciences

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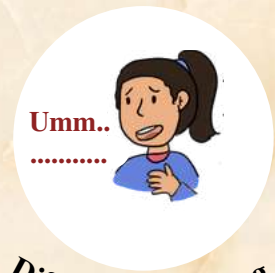

You should see a speech language pathologist if these symptoms are present:



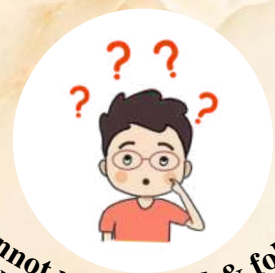

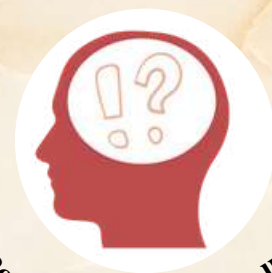

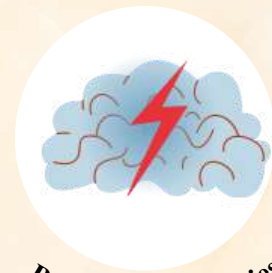
